The Argyle® Zip Scuff is a 150mm, lace-up ankle boot with an industrial gradeside zip for easy, quick access, and an abrasion resistant, scuff cap toe cover for extra protection to the leather.

Description

150mm derby style zip and lace-up ankle boot with padded collar and tongue plus scuff cap.

Upper Materials

Full-grain (black) or nubuck (sand and wheat) cowhide water-resistant leather upper and a double stitched in nylon thread. Non-corrosive lacing.

Toe Cap

200J Safety Steel.

Lining Materials

This boot is lined with Baltico®, which is a soft, non-abrasive, hydrophobic material that wicks perspiration away from the foot, enabling the skin to remain cool and dry. Fresche Quatlock™, a sustainable and renewable resource, is applied during the manufacturing process to provide antibacterial and antimicrobial protection to the boot.

Full Innersole

A full length footbed that is inserted into the footwear to offer additional support and comfort. This footbed is made from soft polyurethane that will retain its shape and thickness throughout the life of the boot.

Insole

Heavy-duty, flexible antibacterial non-woven insole.

Midsole

Directly moulded Polyurethane midsole for greater shock absorption.

Outsole

Anti-static Thermoplastic Urethane (TPU) outsole for superior wear properties. Heat resistant to 130°C.
